SB 393 would remove homeschool student's exemption from truancy-custody actions.

SB 394 would require annual notification of home-schools, and submission of academic reports to local officials.

Duties of PCHEA officers:

(ART.6)

The **Leader** shall preside at all meetings for PCHEA. The leader shall also be the contact person for sending information to prospects on home education &/or PCHEA.

*A **Co-leader** may be appointed to assist with leadership; either a former leader as an advisor, or the incoming leader for a season of training.*

The **Treasurer** will be responsible for all money paid to PCHEA, and the disbursement of money for the operation of PCHEA. HE/she shall maintain a bank account and records as well as any other balance sheets and financial information.

The **Secretary** will be responsible for keeping minutes at all business meetings or called meetings. He/she shall maintain the membership names and directory and keep the newsletter editor updated of member information.

The Mentor **Coordinator** shall work within PCHEA to match willing mentor families to those who seek advice, and support in regard to home education. the Mentor Coordinator shall be available to new PCHEA members at the fall business meeting.
