Park Manager's Report

- Maintenance currently has a large pile of firewood. During standard operating times they welcome members bundling the wood; the park staff will bring them to the Park Office to sell. They will recommend a donation of \$5 that will be placed in the bird house donation box; hopefully this can continue throughout the summer.
- Jay recommended a metal lockbox for donations for security reasons.
- There was no change in the CCC/POW museum status; they are still waiting for engineering approval from the state.
- Why do we need our own insurance for the Moscow Rd house? New York State is the landlord of the house and property. We are an external entity therefore we have to have our own insurance for liability. This is the same for caterers, etc. that use park facilities.

- A team of about 6-7 volunteers worked on two Saturdays. They bundled about 3 face cords of wood already.
- Bundles are currently too heavy. Next time they will split them smaller and make bundles that are easier to carry.
- Dan is cutting down trees at the CCC camp that are marked by Park employees.
